Forty years ago exhibitions of photography as an art form appeared very infrequently, especially in the San Joaquin Valley. It was at this time a growing number of photographic artists began to meet in a rented gallery and darkroom by the name of Photo-Synthesis. By 1979, this group of local photographers had formed a not-for-profit cooperative to create a local forum for the fine art of photography. In 1980, the group rented a space in the Fresno Tower District. With respect to the broad variety of work produced by its members, it became known as "Spectrum Art Gallery."
